Title	Care needed	Desired outcomes	Care interventions
Activities and entertainment	Donald requires stimulation and enjoyment through entertainment	Maintain present levels of cognition, ability and emotional well-being	Carer to ensure Donald is offered the opportunity of joining peers to enjoy entertainment. This may include listening to music, playing a musical instrument or watching a film.
Eating and drinking	Donald is able to eat and drink independently but needs encouragement to maintain sugar free diet	Maintain independence and dignity and good fluid intake	Donald can eat and drink without help but 1 X carer to offer and encourage Donald have sugar free drinks and sugar free food.
Toileting and continence	Donald uses toilet/commode without assistance but requires prompting due to frequency caused by prostrate problems	To maintain comfort, independence and dignity	Carer to promote continence. Donald can use the toilet unaided but requires prompting 2 hourly. Carer to monitor and record any accidents or changes
Dementia	Donald has short term memory loss.	To maintain independence and safety.	Staff to provide reassurance, understanding and orientation through reminiscence, therapies and activities of daily living.
Maintaining comfort and safety	Donald cannot mobilize without assistance.	To maintain independence	1 X carer to assist and escort and offer reassurance to Donald as required to maintain independence.

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
